1. QT – swimmers who do not meet the qualifying time are ineligible to enter an event.
2. The meet shall be conducted under the rules of SNSW. This meet has area approval.
3. Age is at 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2019. All swimmers must be registered with Swimming NSW.
4. All events shall be conducted as timed finals.
5. Swimmers entering 25m events are not eligible to swim the 50m event of the same stroke.
6. Athletes with a disability must identify themselves to the referee before the start of the session they are competing in, in order to contest MC events.
7. Entries cost \$5.50 per event.
8. Entries must be placed via the online entry system available on our club website [www.springwoodswimmingclub.com.au](http://www.springwoodswimmingclub.com.au). **Entries close 5pm Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2019**, or when entry limit (1200) has been reached.
9. The start list, program and timeline will be available to download at [www.springwoodswimmingclub.com.au](http://www.springwoodswimmingclub.com.au) once completed. Limited programs will be available for \$5.00 on the day.
10. Late entries (after online entry is closed) will only be accepted to fill empty lanes, and will be placed as exhibition swims. Exhibition swimmers cannot place. Entry fees must be received before the start of the meet or the swimmer will be withdrawn.
11. Semi-automatic timing will be used.
12. TM results will be available from [www.springwoodswimmingclub.com.au](http://www.springwoodswimmingclub.com.au) after the meet.

14. Normal pool entry applies.
15. BBQ will be available for breakfast and lunch. There is **NO** longer a canteen at Springwood Aquatic Centre.
16. Results will be published to Meet Mobile throughout the meet.
17. Assistance with timekeeping is required. Clubs will be allocated a lane. Parents, please come prepared to help as we are unable to run this meet without timekeepers.
18. Medals will be awarded for 12/U swimmers. Cash prizes will be awarded for 13/O swimmers. Cash prizes consist of \$7 for 1<sup>st</sup>, \$5 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and \$3 for 3<sup>rd</sup>.
19. Age groups for placings in 50m & 100m events will include 8/U, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs & 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15/O. Age groups for 200FR and 200IM will include 10/U, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13/14yrs, 15/O. Age groups for 200m form strokes will include 12/U and 13/O only. 400m swims are Open events.
20. All entrants in 25m events will receive a certificate and ribbon for each race.
21. Space and seating are extremely limited. Visitors are encouraged to bring their own chairs.
